Members will be aware that the Committee made some adjustments to the ride calendar in an attempt to encourage greater participation in Sunday Leisurely Group rides.

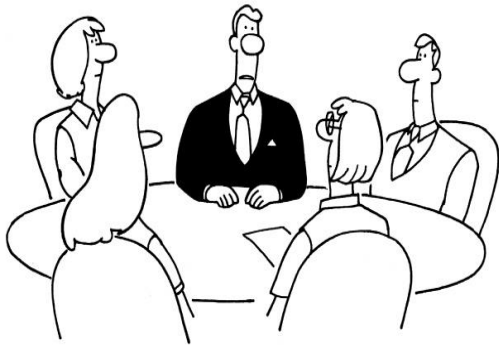
The changes were:
